




Ivo and Jadranka, two siblings from Croatia, recently moved to Austria for studies and a better life.

A few days ago, Ivo discovered a swollen lymph on his neck and decided to search for health information online as he doesn't speak German well enough to go to the doctor.


Let's see together what kind of information he found and help him navigate through the traps of false information.
